



TERMS and CONDITIONS

Please ensure you read and fully understand our booking terms and conditions. If anything is unclear, please contact us so we can explain in further detail to avoid any misunderstandings.

Bookings are subject to the following terms and conditions:

- A contract between you and the owners of The Burrow will come into existence when payment is received and a booking confirmation is issued, showing the confirmed holiday dates. The contract binds you & all the members of your party. It is your responsibility to ensure that all members of your party accept the terms of the contract set out in these terms & conditions of booking. Failure to disclose all relevant information or comply with these terms may lead to termination of the contract & loss of the booking.
- A 20% deposit of the holiday cost is payable at the time of booking. Bookings made less than two weeks before your arrival date must be paid in full.
- The balance must be paid no later than two weeks before the commencement of your holiday. If the balance is not received by the due date, then your holiday will be treated as a cancellation.
- We offer free cancellations but must be notified in writing to info@theburrowscottishborders.com. If you cancel your holiday more than 3 days before it is due to start, then your deposit will be returned.
- If you cancel less than 3 days before the holiday and we cannot find a suitable exchange date within 6 months of the original reservation date, then you will be charged 50% of the total price of the reservation.
- We strongly advise that you take out comprehensive travel insurance to cover cancellations. If you choose not to, then you accept responsibility for any loss that you may incur due to your cancellation.
- Your booking will not be cancelled by the owner except in exceptional circumstances beyond our control. Notification will be given of the cancellation as soon as possible and we will promptly refund all payments made for your holiday. Our liability for cancellation will be limited to payments made to us.
- No parties or events – the maximum number of persons using the accommodation at any time must not exceed 2 persons and only those listed on the booking form can occupy the property. We reserve the right to terminate the booking without notice and without refund in case of a breach of this condition.
- Bookings cannot be accepted from persons under eighteen years of age.
- The owner reserves the right to refuse a booking without giving any reason.
- We, or our representatives, reserve the right to enter the property at any time to undertake essential maintenance or for inspection purposes.
- Tenancies normally commence at 3pm on day of arrival, unless otherwise agreed, and guests are required to vacate the rental by 10am on the day of departure. This allows the accommodation to be thoroughly cleaned and prepared for incoming guests. Late check out may incur a charge.

- Vaping or smoking anywhere inside the premises will result in immediate termination of occupancy and forfeiture of all payments. This must be strictly adhered to, and any damage or extra cleaning caused smoking will be at your expense.
- Dogs
 - One well-behaved dog is allowed at The Burrow.
 - The dog is allowed throughout the downstairs areas (lounge, kitchen and rear courtyard).
 - The dog is not allowed upstairs.
 - The dog should not be left in the house unattended at any time.
 - Please use a suitable crate/bed overnight.
 - The dog should not be allowed onto the furniture – except for the sofa. If your dog does like to sit on the sofa, then please use the fleece dog throw provided in the dog box.
 - Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their dog. Poo bags are provided.
 - Any damage caused by the dogs will be at your expense.
- Damage – In making a booking you accept responsibility for any theft, breakage or damage caused by you, pets or any member of your party and agree to indemnify us in full for any loss that we may incur as a result.
- Damages and breakages – please treat the facilities and accommodation with due care so that other guests may continue to enjoy them. If you notice something is missing or damaged in your accommodation, please let us know immediately so that we can take the appropriate action. If there has been any damage or breakages during your stay, we would be grateful if you could report them promptly, especially before check-out. The accommodation will be inspected at the end of the holiday & you may be charged for any loss or damage.
- Please do not move any furniture from one room to another.
- Please remove shoes before entering the house.
- Please lock the doors and close the windows when you leave the property unoccupied.
- Please make sure you switch off lights, heating or any electrical appliances when you go out – we're an eco-friendly holiday home.
- The owner reserves the right to make a charge to cover additional cleaning costs if the client leaves the property in an unacceptable condition.
- Please note that if any keys issued are not returned at the end of your stay, then the cost of replacement will be charged to you.
- The client may in no circumstance re-let or sublet the property, even free of charge.
- The owner shall not be liable for any temporary defect or malfunction of any equipment, machinery or appliance in the building or grounds.
- No compensation will be given for any temporary outage of electricity, water, internet connection or television service.
- The owners are not responsible for the loss of any personal belongings or valuables of the guest.
- All inventory must remain in the property and not be taken to another property.
- Please park your vehicle directly in front of The Burrow, ensuring cars do not block access to properties on either side.
- Electric vehicle (EV) charging is not permitted at the property at any time.
- Please respect the community and try to keep noise levels to a minimum, especially between 11 pm and 8 am.

- We reserve the right to terminate a holiday without compensation where the unreasonable behaviour of the persons named on the booking may impair the enjoyment, comfort or health of others.
- Candles are not allowed inside the house.
- Check-out – please leave The Burrow as you found it. You are welcome to leave the dishwasher running as you leave. You do not need to strip beds or empty bins. Ensure that all window and door locks are secure and return the keys back into the key box.
- Any problem or complaint which the client may have concerning their holiday must be immediately reported directly to us and we will endeavour to put matters right. Any complaints not reported to us at the time and only reported after the client has returned from holiday will not be considered by the proprietor.
- We reserve the right to make reasonable amendments or additions to these terms and conditions without notice.
- This property is privately owned and is our home. We expect all guests to enjoy the facilities and treat the property with the same respect that they would with their own home.
